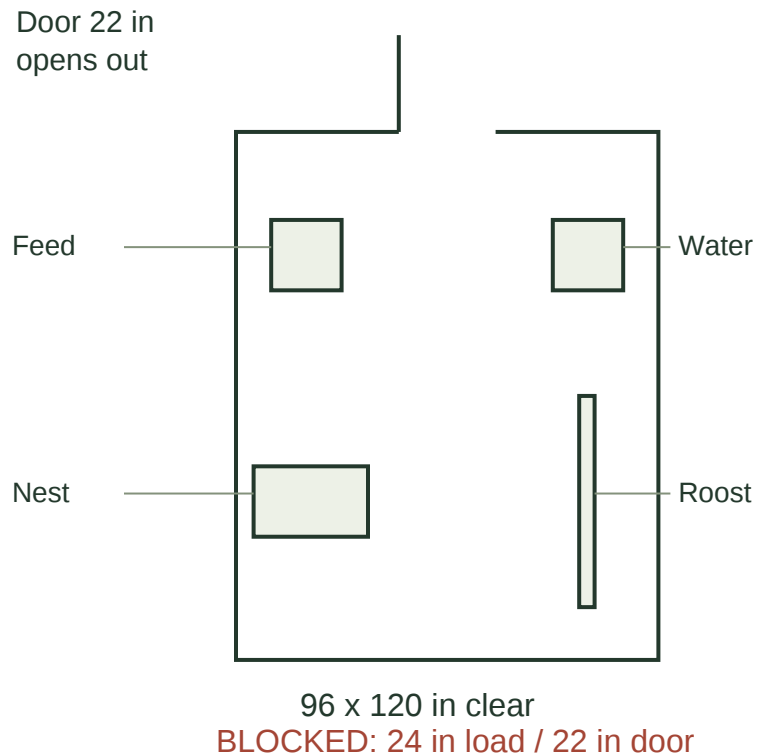


1. Identify the limiting opening

Same 96 x 120 in room and furniture, but the measured clear front opening is 22 in. The 24 in loaded water container cannot pass in the stated orientation.

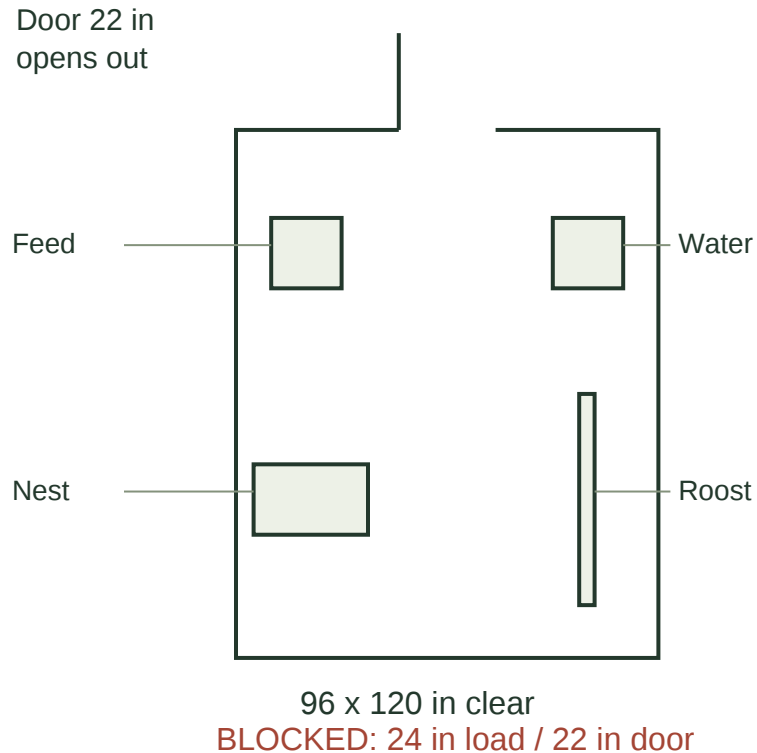


Measure between the actual door stops with the leaf held fully open. A 24 in loaded width exceeds the 22 in opening by 2 in; the room area does not resolve that mismatch.

Contents can travel in the smaller measured carrier. Removal of the original waterer is still unresolved; no structural doorway enlargement is prescribed.

2. Decant before moving the equipment

Same 96 x 120 in room and furniture, but the measured clear front opening is 22 in. The 24 in loaded water container cannot pass in the stated orientation.

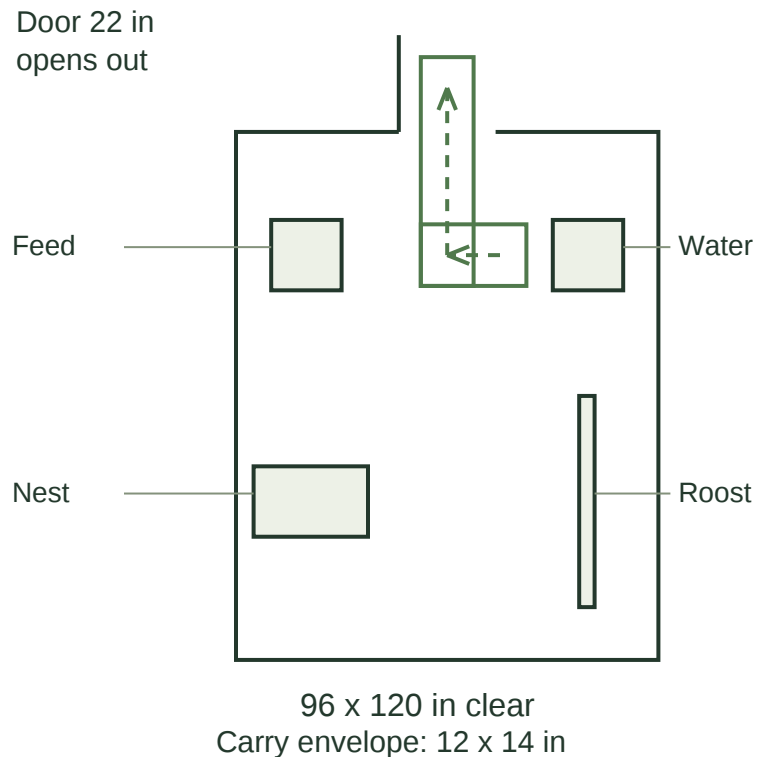


Secure birds, isolate the supply, and empty into manageable smaller containers. Re-measure the empty waterer including its rigid handles; do not assume that removing water makes the object narrower.

Contents can travel in the smaller measured carrier. Removal of the original waterer is still unresolved; no structural doorway enlargement is prescribed.

3. Use a measured 12 x 14 in carrier

Same 96 x 120 in room and furniture, but the measured clear front opening is 22 in. The 24 in loaded water container cannot pass in the stated orientation.

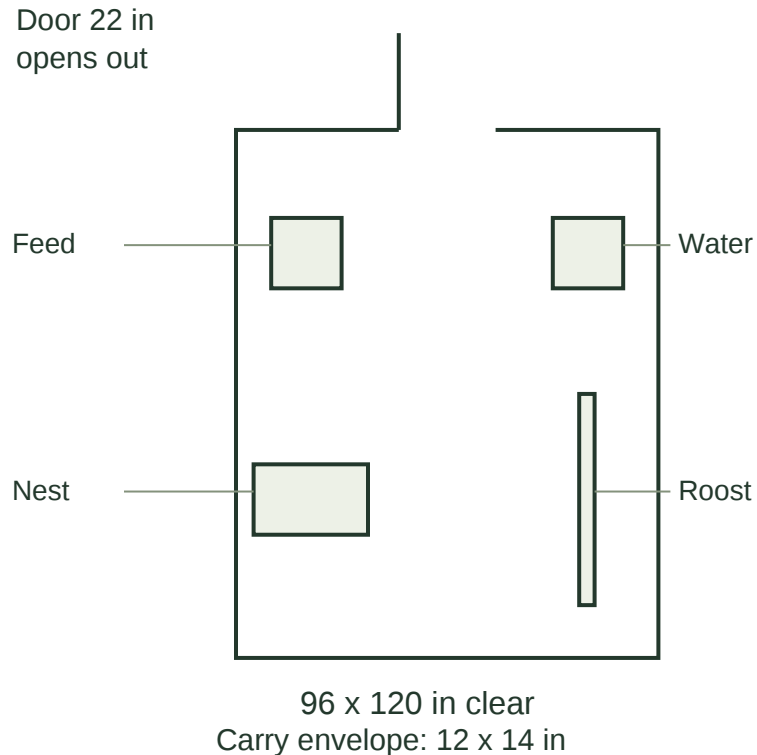


This alternative moves the contents in a 12 x 14 in carrier, not the original oversized waterer. Move it from the refill point to the central lane and out. The original waterer remains indoors until it is dismantled, replaced, or an independently designed opening change is completed.

Contents can travel in the smaller measured carrier. Removal of the original waterer is still unresolved; no structural doorway enlargement is prescribed.

4. Clean only the accessible scope

Same 96 x 120 in room and furniture, but the measured clear front opening is 22 in. The 24 in loaded water container cannot pass in the stated orientation.

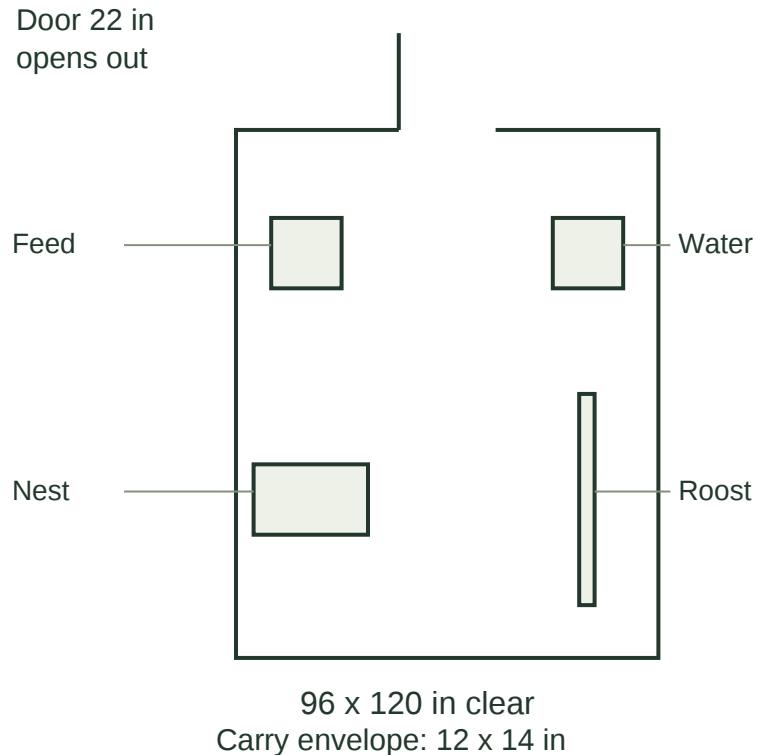


A smaller carrier enables waste or water transport. It does not provide access beneath an immovable waterer. Record that unresolved area and resolve equipment removal before calling this a full clean-out.

Contents can travel in the smaller measured carrier. Removal of the original waterer is still unresolved; no structural doorway enlargement is prescribed.

5. Keep the unresolved removal task

Same 96 x 120 in room and furniture, but the measured clear front opening is 22 in. The 24 in loaded water container cannot pass in the stated orientation.



Return supplies with the smaller carrier and secure the equipment. Retain the waterer-removal issue in the project; do not mark a complete empty-room clean as finished.

Contents can travel in the smaller measured carrier. Removal of the original waterer is still unresolved; no structural doorway enlargement is prescribed.
